### BARROS & ERRÁZURIZ ABOGADOS SCHOLARSHIP

#### CALL FOR GRADUATES 2018

#### 1. Objective

Students who graduate from law school this year are invited to apply for a scholarship called "Barros & Errázuriz Scholarship" (hereinafter also, the "Scholarship").

The Scholarship is a benefit granted by the law firm Barros & Errázuriz, aimed at graduates in the career of Law from all the law schools of accredited and recognized universities in the country.

The scholarship will be aimed at those students who graduate from law school in the year 2018 with benefits that will become effective during the year 2019, which includes the period of study for the degree exam or completion of mandatory professional internship.

#### 2. Profile of the Scholars

People with intellectual endeavors, demonstrating leadership, academic excellence and personal responsibility, who have maintained ethical and persevering attitudes throughout their university degree, while proving economic needs.

#### 3. Benefits of the Scholarship

The Scholarship will include the benefits indicated below:

- 3.1. A monthly allowance of up to \$ 250,000, for a period of 7 months, all of which should fall within the year following the graduation of the applicant.
- 3.2. Internship for a period of 3 months at the offices of Barros and Errázuriz, in the area of interest of the scholar. Said internship will be carried out in the months Barros & Errázuriz determines and, in any case, after satisfactory approval of the degree exam on the part of the scholar and provided that the latter has approved said examination within 12 months after the corresponding graduation date.

#### 4. Application Requirements

- 4.1. To have graduated from law school from any university located in the national territory, in the year 2018.
- 4.2. To prove economic needs, i.e., that the applicant presents difficulties in financing their expenses during the period of preparation of the degree exam or carrying out the mandatory professional internship.

The economic needs of the applicant will be accredited by a certificate from a social worker of the University the applicant belongs to.

- 4.3. To accredit a good academic performance, considering that the applicant fulfills this requirement if his grade point average is within 20% of the best averages of his graduating class. The above will be accredited through a certificate of ranking from the corresponding school. In the event that it is not possible for the applicant to submit said ranking certificate, provided this information is not available in the respective school, the applicant may apply for the Scholarship by proving an average grade equal to or greater than 5.5 by means of certificates issued by the corresponding university that give an account of the grade transcripts of the applicant and the respective average.
- 4.4. To demonstrate leadership throughout his or her university degree, intellectual endeavor, and a trajectory in the field of social action and integration in the community.

## 5. Documentation required

- 5.1. Application form, duly completed.
- 5.2. Certificate of graduation extended by the corresponding faculty or school of law.
- 5.3. Certificate of ranking of average grades extended by the corresponding faculty or school of law, or grade transcripts, as appropriate.
- 5.4. Certification of socioeconomic level of the applicant's family group, extended by the social worker of the applicant's university.
- 5.5. Essay written by the applicant describing the motive for application to the Scholarship and the reasons for which the applicant believes to be worthy of it. The essay must have a maximum of one letter-sized page, with *Times New Roman letter No. 12*.

## 6. Modality and period of application

Applications must be made within the application term, which corresponds to the period between December 15, 2018 and January 31, 2019.

In this regard, to apply, interested parties should access the Barros & Errázuriz website ([www.bye.cl](http://www.bye.cl)), in the section Our Firm - Social Responsibility, B & E Scholarship, where the application terms will be included.

The application terms contain the application form, which must be printed and completed by the applicant, with the information required therein.

The corresponding documentation, and indicated in item 5 above, may be sent by certified mail or delivered personally to the offices of Barros & Errázuriz, located at Avenida Isidora Goyenechea 2939, piso 10, comuna de Las Condes, Santiago.

The documents must be delivered in a sealed envelope, addressed to Barros & Errázuriz, Attention: "Barros & Errázuriz Scholarship".

The background information must be received at the offices of Barros & Errázuriz within the corresponding application deadline. Documents accompanied after the aforementioned period will be considered not presented.

## 7. Selection process

The selection and evaluation of the academic and socioeconomic background of the candidates will correspond to a selection committee of Barros & Errázuriz (the "Selection Committee"), which will define a list of 10 preselected candidates with the respective background information.

Those who are shortlisted will be interviewed by the Selection Committee, in the month of March 2019. The preselected candidates will be called a week before the interview.

The Selection Committee will choose the beneficiary taking into consideration, in addition to the aforementioned background, the candidate's spirit of leadership, intellectual endeavor and a trajectory in the field of social action and integration in the community.

The final selection will take place at the end of March 2019.

All information to the applicant (pre-selection, call for interview and results) will be done through email. Therefore, it is recommended that applicants take all precautions to keep their email address current. The final decision of the Selection Committee will also be communicated personally or by registered letter to the beneficiary.

Barros & Errázuriz reserves the right to declare the contest vacant if, in its exclusive judgment, none of the applicants meets the necessary requirements to be a beneficiary of the Scholarship. In this way, the applicants recognize that they accept this reservation of rights for the mere fact of submitting to this contest.

## 8. Compliance and confidentiality

- 8.1. Compliance with all the conditions established in these rules will be required.
- 8.2. Applications submitted by fax or by e-mail, late or incomplete will be considered outside of the terms.
- 8.3. The application documents will not be returned.
- 8.4. The application process and the background information delivered will be confidential.
